# **PRINCIPALS:**

3. Our light should God's Mercy. *Matthew 5:7 - "Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy. (ESV)*

Hebrews 13:15 - Through him then let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that acknowledge his name. (ESV)

*Matthew 7:20* - Thus you will recognize them by their fruits. (ESV)
