Every day we have faith building opportunities. The problem is most of us don't recognize them when they appear. We flunk the test because we don't even realize it is a test, and that God is trying to help us grow. So if God wants me to live by faith, and if God builds my faith by testing it, then the natural question is how does God do it?

1) God test our faith through

**1 Peter 1:6-7 (ESV)** In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials, <sup>7</sup> so that the tested genuineness of your faith—more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire—may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

That's trials, problems, pressures, tough circumstances. The difficulties that come into our lives, come to test and prove our faith.

*James 1:2-3 (ESV)* Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, <sup>3</sup> for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness.
